
Attorney Schlundt,
Deputy Commissioner Cantillo forwarded me your email regarding Mr. Cardilli.

As you know, the Department denied Mr. Cardilli's SCCP application and his appeal. As Classification Director Curtis noted in an email to you, due to confidentiality laws, there is no additional information that the Department can give you or Mr. Cardilli regarding the reasons for the denial.

As the appeal process is complete, there is no further review of the decision, per Policy 27.02, Procedure O, paragraph 8 (attached). We note that this policy is subject to the APA, and MDOC cannot change the policy without going through the APA process.

As Deputy Commissioner Cantillo suggested, Mr. Cardilli should apply again when closer to his release date and may seek to transfer to a minimum facility, where there are more programs off-grounds.

Thanks for the email. This is admittedly getting messy with so many people involved so I think correspondence between the two of us may be most efficient. I understand there is no further administrative appeal as things stand right now. I have been trying to get some clarification as to the denial of his application. His denial and appeal denial noted concerns from the community and concerns with his overall plan. While concerns of the community may be confidential, we have not received any input as to his plan. Any feedback that Mark has received within the prison has been that his plan is approved, so it is not clear what conditions need to be amended or added when he reapplies. He has been looking for any sort of guidance as to what the concerns are with his plan so it can be properly addressed.
